Our manifesto asks politicians to agree to:

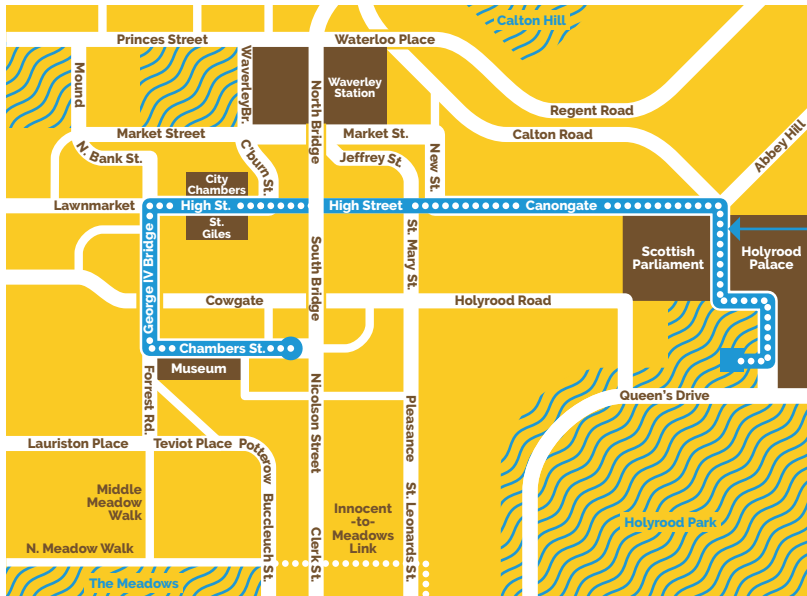
- **Proper funding for active travel** – starting at 10% of the transport budget and rising to 20% by the end of the parliamentary term.

- **Implement and enforce safer speeds** where people live, work and play.
